# Title of the Lesson Plan: Human Migration/ Technique: Read and Run

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School: Ben Arous/Rades area

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## A) Target Audience (age, level of language)

18 year-olds, advanced level (4th form secondary)

### **B)** Estimated Time

One hour and a half

## C) Aims (Rationale)

Practise scanning for information

Exercise learners' memory

### D) Materials

Visuals: pictures of people moving; maps and graphics (from the text)

## E) Presentation (Pre-Lesson Warm-Up, Instructions and Extended Activities) Pre-Lesson Warm-Up

Make use of the visuals, maps and graphics to introduce key words.

Elicit definitions of migration and reasons.

#### Instructions

- 1. Stick 2 different texts, text A and text B, with different questions in different places
- 2. Divide the class into groups and assign the questions according to the students' level, the easy one to the weak and to more complicated to the top students.
- 3. Students read the questions and run to read the text and find the answer, then report to the group.

### Extended or Follow Up Activities (optional)

If you are given the choice, will you migrate? Why or why not? State your reasons.

Parallel writing: animal migration: produce a passage.

Provide pupils with a map of Tunisia to indicate migration in Tunisia

### F) Assessment

The group that finishes first is the winner.
