# E) Presentation (Pre-Lesson Warm-Up, Instructions and Extended Activities)

## Pre-Lesson Warm-Up

Use realia; show them a story to introduce the phrase "fairy tale."

Prediction: Predict the type of characters that you can find in a fairy tale.

Brainstorming: Jot down words related to the characters.

### Instructions

- 1. Interactive Read Aloud technique: the teacher divides the text into section. Then, he reads aloud (using intonation/facial expression/gestures/different voices).
- 2. At the end of every section, she/he stops to check the understanding of the new vocab and ask some questions about what has been read. For example, Who are the characters? Where do the events take place? What are the new events. Note: The questions depend on what is seen in the section.
