

**Title of the Lesson Plan:** Child Labour: Prediction/Jigsaw Reading/Role Play

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**A) Target Audience (age, level of language)**

**E) Presentation (Pre-Lesson Warm-Up, Instructions and Extended Activities)**

*Pre-Lesson Warm-Up*

Predict the topic through describing and comparing two pictures. Picture 1 shows a working child, Picture 2 shows a child at school. Pupils should come up with a topic like Child Rights

*Instructions*

1. Divide the class into four groups and the text into four parts
2. Ask each group to read a part and identify the main idea
3. Members of each group will move and exchange information with the other groups. They will develop a summary of the text by identifying the causes, working conditions, consequences, and number of working children in the world.
