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A) Target Audience (age, level of language)

8th form (Basic school), 12-15 years old

B) Estimated Time

50 minutes

C) Aims (Rationale)

Ability to read and understand a long dialogue

Ability to read for details

Ability to guess the meaning of new vocabulary

Ability to use new vocabulary in context

D) Materials

Visuals, realia, textbook

E) Presentation (Pre-Lesson Warm-Up, Instructions and Extended Activities)

Pre-Lesson Warm-Up

Match visuals with the corresponding utterances

Ask WH- and yes/no questions

Act and mime to introduce new vocabulary

Instructions

- 1. Divide the class into six groups and assign a specific task for each group.
