A) Target Audience (age, level of language)

13 years old, 8th form

B) Estimated Time

35 minutes

C) Aims (Rationale)

To better know about the Olympic Games

D) Materials

Visuals: picture of the Olympic flag and torch, different pictures of Olympic sports Board, 2 big papers for the written texts, worksheet

E) Presentation (Pre-Lesson Warm-Up, Instructions and Extended Activities) Pre-Lesson Warm-Up

Look at the pictures of the Olympic flag and torch. Ask them what the five colored circles represent and what they symbolize.

Instructions

- 1. Divide the class into two parts, A and B. Provide each with a set of questions they should try to answer without reading the passages. Write the answers on the board.
- 2. Stick the passages on both sides of the classroom. Ask Group A to read the passage of Group B and correct their answers. Ask Group B to do the same thing with the answers of Group A.
- 3. Use a spidergram in which pupils collect their own ideas.

Extended or Follow Up Activities (optional)

From the spidergram, pupils write a short paragraph about the Olympic Games.

F) Assessment

Each group of four pupils should collaborate to create a new symbol for the Olympic Games.
