Title of the Lesson Plan: Marie Celeste

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School: Monastir Preparatory Schools

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A) Target Audience (age, level of language)

Teenagers (15 years old), 9th form of basic education

B) Estimated Time

50 minutes

C) Aims (Rationale)

Learners will be able to:

Actively use the structure in focus ((un)certainty) Comprehend the text and respond to it

D) Materials

Textbook and visuals in the textbook

E) Presentation (Pre-Lesson Warm-Up, Instructions and Extended Activities) Pre-Lesson Warm-Up

Game: the teacher divides the learners into groups. Each member will be given a sheet with an activity on it. The other groups have to guess what the activity is through the gestures one person performs. The teacher intervenes each time to introduce the structure.

Instructions

- 1. Read and predict (skimming): Guess what the "Marie Celeste" is. Learners will rely on three visuals to decide and use the above-mentioned structure.
- 2. The teacher divides the learners into two groups and asks them to close their books and look at the two parts of the text to fill in a chart (Read and Run).
- 3. Learners respond to multiple-choice questions to find the relationship between the two ships.

Extended or Follow Up Activities (optional)

(Speaking) What do you think happened to the "Marie Celeste"?

F) Assessment

The teacher distributes a text about the Titanic for the learners to read and summarize.
