# **Title of the Lesson Plan:** A Mark of Excellence (Level 4, Lesson 22)

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## A) Target Audience (age, level of language)

Upper intermediate (18-20 years old)

### **B)** Estimated Time

60 minutes

### C) Aims (Rationale)

Enable pupils to read and understand an extended text, infer the writer's bias, simulate roles (interview)

#### D) Materials

Visuals, textbook, print-out of the title and subtitle

# E) Presentation (Pre-Lesson Warm-Up, Instructions and Extended Activities) Pre-Lesson Warm-Up

Put the visuals on the board and ask the students to jot down metaphors to express their feelings toward the Bac exam.

#### Instructions

- 1. Give the students print-outs of the title and subtitle and ask them to focus on the punctuation (? versus !)
- 2. Give two possible interpretations, depending on the punctuation
- 3. Paraphrase the title and subtitle
- 4. Read the text and find out which explanation the writer supports. Justify your answer. => Do you think the writer is objective or biased?

## Extended or Follow Up Activities (optional)

Role-play an interview between a journalist and the Minister of Education Hints to help learners: Are they really excellent results?
