A) Target Audience (age, level of language)

15-16 years old; 1st and second form, secondary education

B) Estimated Time

2 hours

C) Aims (Rationale)

To read for pleasure

To scan, skim, and understand a narrative text

To twist the text into sequences / acting

D) Materials

Album (realia), visuals, worksheets

E) Presentation (Pre-Lesson Warm-Up, Instructions and Extended Activities)

Pre-Lesson Warm-Up

Introduce active vocabulary through materials and Q&A session.

Instructions

1. Divide students into groups.
2. Give students worksheets/texts and ask each group to read a different portion of the text silently.
3. Read the text again aloud at their own pace, and then to listen to each other's reading. Between each section of the story, the teacher intervenes to help them discuss the story or predict what will happen next.

Extended or Follow Up Activities (optional)

Speaking: discuss the story and the ending

Creative writing: rewrite the story, adding more suspense

Picture story: match pictures with story events / sections

Real lives: tell or read a similar story

Journaling: summary and response

Guess another ending / choose another title for the story
