

Title of the Lesson Plan: Reading for Pleasure (Lesson 18)

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Date: 14 February 2006

A) Target Audience (age, level of language)

Beginners/ 15 years old

B) Estimated Time

50 minutes

C) Aims (Rationale)

Reading for gist

Infer meaning of unfamiliar words from context

Retelling a known story

D) Materials

Short stories/visuals

E) Presentation (Pre-Lesson Warm-Up, Instructions and Extended Activities)

Pre-Lesson Warm-Up

Bring some stories to the classroom.

Ask pupils about their favourite story (real, imaginary, fairy).

Show them a picture that relates to the story they're going to read (a picture of a monster and ask them to imagine what this animal is going to do) - guessing.

Instructions

1. Read the story.
2. Tick the right title (a, b, or c).
3. Fill in the chart with information from the story.

Place	Time	Characters

4. Read the story and match each paragraph with the sentence that summarizes it.

Extended or Follow Up Activities (optional) (group work)

Divide the class into groups.

Provide the pupils with scrambled drawings (the different scenes of the story) and ask them to reorder the drawings, then to summarize the story with reference to the drawings.

F) Assessment

(Homework) Retell a story that you know and the best version is going to be published in the school magazine.
