## A) Target Audience (age, level of language)

9th graders (about 15 years old)

#### **B)** Estimated Time

1 hour

## C) Aims (Rationale)

By the end of the lesson, learners should have practice in:

Scanning a text for specific details; skim; read for gist; read for details

Inferring meaning of unfamiliar words from context

Reordering a sequence of events to get a summary

Inferring/identifying settings, plot and main characters

Identifying the genre of a text

## D) Materials

Visuals and gestures

## E) Presentation (Pre-Lesson Warm-Up, Instructions and Extended Activities) Pre-Lesson Warm-Up

Questions: How do you spend your free time? What activities do you like doing? Spider-gram(s)

Predict content/main idea/topic from visuals/core vocabulary (monster, castle, treasure)

#### **Instructions**

- 1. Assign a silent reading of the text (20 minutes)
- 2. Ask learners to identify the genre of the text, the setting (time and place), and the principal and secondary characters
- 3. Ask questions that can be useful for identifying the main events in the plot
- 4. Elicit vocabulary and label visuals
- 5. Elicit learners' attitudes toward the characters and their deeds in the story
- 6. Ask questions about attitudes and opinions, such as "How do you like..." and "What do you think of ..." =>consolidating expressions of opinion and attitudes
